Who We Are Rural Health Initiative (RHI) is a 501(c)3 non-profit, community-supported, program focused on **improving and sustaining the health and safety of farm families** through our unique concept of "Kitchen Wellness".

We are NOT an insurance company, NOT a government-funded program, and we DO NOT have income limits.

Services Provided

Our "Kitchen Wellness" includes:

- **COMPLIMENTARY (free), in-home/on-site preventative health screening(s).** Our staff comes to you at a convenient time. Visits are casual and take about 20 minutes per person.
- **IMMEDIATE results** of your blood pressure, blood glucose (blood sugar), cholesterol, and biometrics (height, weight, body mass index)
- **Health coaching** on a variety of topics relevant to your health
- **Referral information** of beneficial and available community resources
